- College Connections plans activities for and sends packages to college students
- Congregational Care Meals provides meals for families in need within our congregation
- Cradle Roll organizes educational/spiritual materials for families with infants/children
- Divorce Care offers support and education for separated or divorced persons
- Nursery cares for our children; organizes nursery programs and facilities
- Parish Health provides health education and resources
- Exceptional Parents & Friends offers support/prayer for those with special needs family members

* FELLOWSHIP

- Adult Food and Forum enjoys lunch, fellowship and an interesting program;
- Book Discussion Group reads and discusses fiction and non-fiction books; monthly
- Congregational Receptions plans special fellowship events
- Dinners for Eight enjoys dinner and fellowship in groups of eight
- Men's Group enjoys breakfast, fellowship and discussion; twice monthly
- Movie Watchers' Group enjoys a movie, fellowship and discussion; monthly
- POP's Cafe serves breakfast to the congregation on Sunday mornings, 4 times/year

- Faith Mission: Christmas provides supplies for Columbus' Faith Mission shelters
- First English Church - Meals provides/cooks food for the hungry near downtown Columbus
- Giving Tree: Christmas provides Christmas gifts for people in group homes
- Global Missions provides awareness and support of world needs and relief efforts
- Habitat for Humanity builds homes for people in need
- Layettes for Little Ones provides needed items for parents of newborns
- Military Personnel Support Support for our deployed military personnel and their families
- Needlework Ministry knits/crochets prayer shawls and hats for those needing comfort
- Ohio Benefit Bank refers/connects local people in need to food, utility, employment assistance
