## What is T.G.I.G.F.?

Thank God It's Good Friday (T.G.I.G.F.) is an annual event at Prince of Peace. You can think of it as a one day Vacation Bible school that is held on Good Friday. Children ages 4 through Grade 4 learn about the events of Holy Week through group singing, classroom activities, age-appropriate crafts, games and science exploration.

## When is it held?

This year, T.G.I.G.F. will be held on Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup> from 9:30 – 11:30 a.m.

## When will I need to be at church?

Please plan to arrive at the church no later than 9:00 a.m. Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup>. You will likely need to stay a little after 11:30 to help ensure your area is clean and that all students have departed with their parents (or designee).

## How will I know what to do?

This fun program is set up as a rotational experience for the children. Class lead teachers will be given materials to tell the Easter Story, but then you take your class group to the different stations for craft, games and science. We will make sure you have everything you need before April 6<sup>th</sup>

## Will there be child care?

We will offer child care for children under 4 whose parents are volunteering at T.G.I.G.F. Please let Sue Miller know if you will be using this service.

## Volunteer Position

## Responsibilities

Preschool/Elementary Class Leaders

Welcome children; play get to know you games; Gather them to tell them the Easter Story; lead them through stations and help them as they participate in the various activities;

Preschool/Elementary Class Assistants

Assist Class Leader; help supervise children in your group

Science Leader

Make sure Science area is set up for each group and that helpers know how to assist children in their explorations; make sure everything is cleaned up after the last group is finished

Science Helper

Assist leader and children during group rotation; assist in clean-up

Snack Leader

Plan and purchase snacks; turn in receipt to director; get snack tables ready for each class group; lead the children in washing their hands and in prayer before snack; coordinate all snack helpers; make sure everything is cleaned up after the last group is finished

Snack Helper

Assist snack leader & children during snack time; assist in clean-up

Games Leader

Plan and lead small and large group games; egg relay

Games Helper

Assist the Games Leader

Nursery for Volunteer's children

Care for children 9-12 on Friday, April 2, 2010 in nursery.

Registration Table

Direct parents to classrooms; take walk-in registrations and payments

Set-up / Decorating

Hang signs; move tables; distribute items to rooms; most of this work can be done during the week prior to T.G.I.G.F. however signs must be hung after worship service on Thursday night and prior to 9:00 a.m. Friday

Clean-up

Remove signs; move tables; collect items from rooms; make sure everything is "back to normal" for the weekend
