## Upcoming Confirmation Course Offerings!



The Confirmation program has four new classes beginning in the next five weeks—utilizing not only Wednesday evenings and Saturday mornings, but also a newly-added time on Sunday afternoons. Here is what's in store:

Our Wednesday/Saturday sessions will have two courses offered, one of which will be a study on the "Revelation of John", the other looking at "Faith and a Bestseller." The first of these will allow students to earn a credit of Bible

study, as the class will seek to work through the final book of the Bible. "Faith and a Bestseller" will give students an opportunity to explore the issues of faith raised by a contemporary novel (still to be named...).

Two additional classes have been added to Sunday afternoons in February and March. "What's in Our Hymnal and How to Use It!" will be a chance for students to learn the ins and outs of the *Evangelical Lutheran Worship* book, also

known as the Red Book. This class will be offered on February 14th and 28th. "The Apostles' Creed," an in-depth look at what all those words really are about, will be offered on March 7th and 14th.

The new Sunday courses will run from 12:30-3:00pm.
